

Glandular Material

All of the statements herein are certified and attested to by the official Argentine Agricultural Agency, called SENASA. A veterinary health certificate is issued for all exports. All imports into the U.S. are accompanied by an official U.S.D.A. Import permit issued on a per lot number basis. The processing plant is cGMP (certified good manufacturing practices) and ISO 9001 Certified, and has been issued an FDA establishment number. All shipments are controlled with a Certificate of Analysis (COFA), and an independent Quality Control laboratory also performs testing.

All the animals used in the processing are from grass only, range fed cattle. No hormones, and no pesticides or insecticides are present during their growth. They would be considered to be an "organic" type animal, because of their method of growth. No official Organic Certification presently exists in Argentina, but this certification will possibly be available in the coming months.

The Republic of Argentina has been guaranteed to be Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE-Mad Cow Disease) free by SENASA.

All glandular materials are obtained from animals younger than 30 months of age.
